



2017 Statistics

Children

- 1,767 children served by CASA volunteers and staff members
 - 72% of the total number of children in Child Protective Services' care in Travis County
- 736 new children assigned to CASA
- 741 children's cases closed with the help of CASA
 - 53% (395) of children were reunified with their parent(s)
 - 25% (184) of children were adopted by or now live permanently with relatives
 - 6% (48) of children were adopted by or now live permanently with non-relatives
 - 6% (44) of children became adults (turned 18) while in care of the state
 - 10% (70) - the remaining children's cases were served by another county court system, had their case dismissed or had other outcomes
- 900 children still needed a CASA volunteer

Volunteers

- 721 active volunteers assigned to children
- 197 new volunteers took a case in 2017

Demographics

- Race and ethnicity of children served:
 - Hispanic/Latino = 51%
 - Black/African-American = 25%
 - White = 16%
 - Bi-Racial/Multi-Racial = 6%
 - Asian/Asian-American = 1%
 - Other/Not Specified = 1%
- Ages and gender of children served:
 - 0-4 = 27%
 - 5-13 = 52%
 - 14-17 = 17%
 - 18 and over = 4%
 - 51% male; 49% female
- Race and ethnicity of active volunteers:
 - Hispanic/Latino = 11%
 - Black/African-American = 4%
 - White = 78%
 - Bi-Racial/Multi-Racial = 2%
 - Asian/Asian-American = 3%
 - Other/Not Specified = 2%
- Ages and gender of active volunteers:
 - 21-29 = 20%
 - 30-39 = 26%
 - 40-49 = 17%
 - 50-59 = 20%
 - 60+ = 17%
 - 14% male; 86% female
